Peter Dobb made his Honley first XI debut in 1948 and, 57 years later, his last match for the club is yet to come. In his first 11 year spell with the club he took 248 wickets for the first XI at a cost of 16.14 each and scored 3978 runs at an average of 27.43. Peter still turns out for the second XI.
